NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANISATION

- 1.1 Organising Authority: Balatonfüredi Yacht Club
1.2 Principal Race Officer: Miklós Rauschenberger
1.3 Chairman of the International Jury: Bojan Gale
Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2.2 The prescriptions of the Hungarian Yachting Association will apply except the General Sailing Instructions for 2016.
2.3 Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
2.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open for competitors of the following classes:

Class	Age of competitors
420	helm and crew born on or after 1 January 1998
Optimist	helm born on or after 1 January 2001

- 4.2 Entry requirements are listed in the Regatta Regulations for 2016 of the Hungarian Yachting Association.
4.3 Entry fee: 5.000 HUF/competitor.
The entry fee shall be paid during the registration.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration and entry:
Place: Regatta Office located in the clubroom of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (H-8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.).
Time: 8 September 2016. 16:00-20:00 hrs
5.2 Dates of racing for all classes: between 9 and 11 September 2016.
5.3 Number of races:
There are 8 races scheduled for each class according to the following schedule:
9 September 2016 3 races
10 September 2016 3 races
11 September 2016 2 races
5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 9 September 2016. 10:00 hrs.
5.5 On the last day of the regatta (11 September 2016) no warning signal will be made after 14:00 hrs.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Copies of Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office during registration.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The regatta centre will be located in the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (H-8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.).

7.2 The racing area will be among Balatonfüred, Alsóörs, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany.

8 COURSE

Trapezoid courses will be sailed.

9 SCORING

9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from four to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9.3 Category results will be determined by extracting boats from the overall results. Competitors of different age groups in the Optimist class will start together, but will be scored separately.

10 COACHES, TEAM LEADERS, SUPPORT BOATS

10.1 Coaches, team leaders and support boats shall register during the time of registration, when they shall list the sail numbers of their supported competitors. Each support boat shall take responsibility for a maximum of ten racing boats.

10.2 Each support boat is recommended to carry an operating VHF radio on board.

10.3 The movements of support boats will be restricted as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

10.4 There will be a coaches meeting in the regatta centre 90 minutes before the first scheduled start time of the first race each day. The objectives of these meetings are to receive feedback from the coaches on the regatta organization, exchange view points and inform the coaches about changes in the sailing instructions and regatta organization in general.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each class.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 5 million HUF per event or the equivalent.

15 MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
