NOTICE OF RACE

ABBREVIATIONS:

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty, which may be less than disqualification, is at the discretion of the protest committee.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Regatta Regulations and the Advertising Code of the Hungarian Yachting Association will apply as rules.

1.2 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. EVENT ADVERTISING [NP] [DP]

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 29er, the 420 and the Optimist classes.

3.2 Athletes and boats shall comply with the entry requirements in Regatta Regulations 3.

3.3 Entry:

(a) Online entry for registered Hungarian boats in the VIHAR system of the Hungarian Yachting Association.

(b) On-site entry: at the race office in the clubroom of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (Zákonyi Ferenc street 2, Balatonfüred 8230), between 16:00 and 19:00 on 7 September 2017.

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee is 7.000 HUF per person.

4.2 Fees shall be paid by cash or cards at registration.

5. QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

- 5.1 When at least 100 boats enter in a class, the regatta will consist of a qualifying and a final series for that class.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Racing days, the scheduled time of warning signals and number of races are as follows:

10 September 2017	10:00	3	2

- 6.2 On the last scheduled day of racing (10 September 2017) no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Boats shall comply with RRS 78.1 from 10:00 on 8 September 2017. Non-compliance from 10:00 on 8 September 2017 until the start of the first race may be protested and penalized as if it were discovered after racing on the first day on which races for that boat have been completed.
- 7.2 Breaches of class rules may result in a penalty less than disqualification at the discretion of the protest committee. **[DP]**

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the race office during registration. The electronic version of the sailing instructions will be available no later than the start of the registration at www.byc.hu.

9. VENUE

- 9.1 The regatta centre will be located in the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (Zákonyi Ferenc street 2, Balatonfüred 8230).
- 9.2 The racing area will be among the waters of Balatonfüred, Alsóörs, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1 Trapezoid and windward-leeward courses will be sailed.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 11.2 RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 11.3 Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.



- (b) When four, five, six or seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.3 In the Optimist class, the junior and cadet age groups will start together, and category results will be determined by extracting boats from the overall results.
- 12.4 When a qualifying/final series is sailed:
- (a) The qualifying series races and the final series races will count for total points in the championship.
 - (b) A qualifying series race will not count until all qualifying series fleets have completed that race.
 - (c) One qualifying series race score will be excluded when calculating the division into final series fleets.
 - (d) If only one final series race is completed it will not be excluded.
 - (e) If two or more final series races are completed then a maximum of one final series race score may be excluded.
 - (f) For the purposes of RRS A4.2 the number of boats entered into a qualifying/final series race will be the number of boats assigned to the largest qualifying fleet.

13. SUPPORT BOATS

- 13.1 Support boats shall register during the time of registration, when they shall list the sail numbers of their supported boats. Each support boat shall take responsibility for a maximum of ten boats.
- 13.2 Each support boat is recommended to carry an operating VHF radio on board.
- 13.3 The movements of support boats will be restricted as defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- 13.4 There will be a team leaders meeting in the regatta centre 2 hours before the first scheduled start time of the first race each day. The objectives of these meetings are to receive feedback from the coaches on the regatta organization, exchange view points and inform the coaches about changes in the sailing instructions and regatta organization in general.

14. BERTHING [DP]

- 14.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

15. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. **[DP]**

16. PRIZES

- 16.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
- (a) 29er top 3,
 - (b) 420 top 3,
 - (c) 420 U17 winner,
 - (d) 420 women winner,
 - (e) Optimist cadet top 6,
 - (f) Optimist youth top 6,
 - (g) Optimist cadet girls top 3,



(h) Optimist youth girls top 3.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

18.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum coverage of 5 Million HUF per incident or the equivalent.

19. MEDIA RIGHTS

19.1 Competitors give their consent to the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club and the event sponsors to use, publish, broadcast or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sound recorded during the event of persons and boats free of any charge.
