NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.3 The prescriptions of the national authority that apply are listed in Attachment 1.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Asso99 class.
- 3.2 For Hungarian competitors: only current, fully paid members of the Hungarian Asso99 Association may enter the regatta.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form and by sending it before 23:59 GMT+1 23 July 2018 via email to byc@byc.hu.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Entry fee is 250 EUR for each boat.
- 4.2 Entry fee shall be paid by bank transfer to the following account:

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration:
Time and date: 16:00-20:00, 28 July 2018
Place: Race Office, Balatonfüredi Yacht Club Clubhouse 1st floor
- 5.2 Opening ceremony and competitors' briefing:
Opening ceremony and competitors' briefing will be held in the regatta center at 11:00 29 July 2018.
- 5.3 Dates of racing will be from 29 July 2018 to 1 August 2018.
- 5.4 Number of races:
Ten races are scheduled.
- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 13:00, 29 July 2018.

5.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15:00.

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 6.2 Each boat shall present one set of sails (one mainsail, one jib and one spinnaker) which will be marked with the event limitation stamp during the time of registration.
- 6.3 There will be no facilities for initial measurement of equipment on site.
- 6.4 Each boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 at 11:00 29 July 2018.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 Printed copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. The electronic version of the Sailing Instructions will be available at www.byc.hu no later than the start of the registration.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 The regatta center will be at the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club. Attachment 2 shows the location of the regatta harbor.
- 8.2 The racing area will be among the waters of Balatonfüred, Siófok, Zamárdi, and Tihany. Attachment 3 shows the location of the racing area.

9. THE COURSES

- 9.1 Windward-leeward courses will be sailed.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. BERTHING

- 12.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour. [DP]

13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 13.1 Boats shall be afloat by 11:00 29 July 2018 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]

14. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

- 14.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta. [DP]

15. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]
- 15.2 The race committee intends to make VHF radio communications to the boats on a channel to be announced in the sailing instructions. It is strongly encouraged that each boat has a VHF radio on board capable of receiving these communications.

16. PRIZES

16.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

18.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500.000 EUR per event or the equivalent.

19. MEDIA RIGHTS

19.1 By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

20. CHANGES TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

20.1 Any changes to this Notice of Race will be posted on the regatta website.

ATTACHMENT 1 – PRESCRIPTIONS OF THE HUNGARIAN YACHTING ASSOCIATION TO THE RACING RULES OF SAILING 2017-2020

Add to rules 61.2, 62.2, and 66:

No fees shall be charged for protests or requests for redress or reopening.

Add to rule 67, Damages:

- (a) Any issue of liability or claim for damages arising from an incident while a boat is bound by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts and not considered by a protest committee.
- (b) A boat that takes a penalty or retires does not thereby admit liability for damages or that she has broken a rule.

Add to rule 70.5(a):

The approval of the Hungarian Yachting Association is required to deny the right to appeal under rule 70.5(a). The request for approval shall be received by the national authority no later than 8 weeks before the first day of racing. Notice of the approval shall be posted on the official notice board.

Add to rule 88.2, Changes to Prescriptions:

Notices of race and sailing instructions shall not change a prescription of the Hungarian Yachting Association.

Add to Appendix R - Procedures for Appeals and Requests:

Appeals and requests shall be sent to the Secretariat of the Hungarian Yachting Association either by post or by email.
