## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### INTRODUCTION

The notation **[NP]** in a rule of the sailing instructions means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

#### 1. RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

#### 2. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Except for changes to the schedule of races or racing area assignments, changes to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than two hours before the scheduled time of the first race affected.

#### 3. [DP] CODE OF CONDUCT

- 3.1 Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.  
3.2 Boats not racing that are on a racing area or passing through a racing area where other boats are racing, shall not interfere other boats racing or official vessels.

#### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals ashore will be displayed on the signal mast of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.  
4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than the times shown below' in the RRS Race Signals AP.

Racing area	Time in minutes
Alfa	45
Bravo, Charlie	60



## 5. RACING AREAS

- 5.1 The racing areas are shown in Addendum 1.  
 5.2 Racing areas will be identified with the following racing area flags.

Racing area	Flag
Alfa	Black letter A on a yellow background
Bravo	White letter B on a green background
Charlie	Black letter C on a white background

## 6. SCHEDULE OF RACES AND RACING AREA ASSIGNMENTS

- 6.1 The schedule of races, including the time of the daily first warning signals and assignment of classes to racing areas are shown in Addendum 2.  
 6.2 To change the schedule of races, an update to Addendum 2 will be posted no later than 20:00 on the previous evening of any race affected.  
 6.3 The race committee may reassign a class to any racing area no later than two hours before the scheduled time of the warning signal. However,  
 (a) when flag AP is displayed ashore, the racing area may be changed until 15 minutes before the AP is removed, and  
 (b) when flag AP is displayed afloat, the racing area may be changed. The race committee signal vessel will display flag L and move to the new racing area.  
 6.4 On the last scheduled day of racing (15 August 2021) no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

## 7. CLASS FLAGS

- 7.1 Class flags are described in the table below.

Class	Flag
Melges 24	Blue M24 sign on a white background
11m OD	White 11m sign on a blue background
8mOD	Red 8M sign on a yellow background
Elliott770	Black E-770 sign on a white background
J/24	Blue class insignia on a white background
Scholtz22	Black S-22 sign on a yellow background
Sudár Regatta	Black S.R sign on a red background

## 8. THE COURSE

- 8.1 The diagram in Addendum 3 shows the course, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.  
 8.2 No later than the warning signal, the race committee signal boat will display the approximate compass bearing of the first leg. Failure to display the compass bearing will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).



## 9. MARKS

9.1 Marks will be as described below.

Mark	Description
1, 4s, 4p	white cylinder
1a	thin yellow cylinder
starting marks	a race committee boat and a spar buoy with an orange flag
finishing marks	a race committee boat and a thin yellow cylinder
new marks	red cylinder

9.2 Marks 1 and 1a are rounding marks.

9.3 Marks 4s and 4p are gate marks. A gate may be laid after the start. When a gate mark is missing, the mark in position is a rounding mark and shall be left to port.

## 10. THE START

10.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starting mark at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.

10.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.

10.3 **[DP]** Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races. The starting area is defined as the area 100 meters from the starting line in all directions.

10.4 A boat that does not start within four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

10.5 The warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable.

## 11. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

11.1 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark as soon as practicable.

11.2 When Mark 1 is changed, Mark 1a will not be reset.

## 12. THE FINISH

12.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the finishing mark at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.

## 13. TIME LIMIT

13.1 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes shall be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1 and A5.2.

## 14. HEARING REQUESTS

14.1 The protest time limit for each class will be 75 minutes after

- the last boat in that class finishes the last race of the day, or
- the display of "AP over A" or "N over A".

However, when "AP over A" is displayed ashore, the protest time limit will be 45 minutes after displaying the signal. Where more of the above cases apply, the protest time limit will be whichever the latest is.



- 14.2 Hearing request forms are available at the race office. Hearing requests shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.
- 14.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the jury rooms near the race office.

**15. SCORING**

- 15.1 To request a correction of an alleged error in posted results, a boat may complete a scoring enquiry form available at the race office.

**16. [DP] [NP] SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- 16.1 Boats not leaving the harbour for a scheduled race shall promptly notify the race office.
- 16.2 On arrival at the racing area, boats shall sail closely by the race committee signal vessel, clearly showing their sail numbers.
- 16.3 A boat that retires from racing
  - (a) shall notify the race committee before leaving the racing area if possible, or
  - (b) shall notify the race office as soon as possible.

**17. [DP] REPLACEMENT OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT**

- 17.1 Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior written approval of the race committee. Except for the deadline for the entry, the substitute competitor shall comply with requirements in Notice of Race 4 and 5.
- 17.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorized by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the committee at the first reasonable opportunity, which may be after the race.

**18. OFFICIAL VESSELS**

- 18.1 Official vessels will be identified as follows.

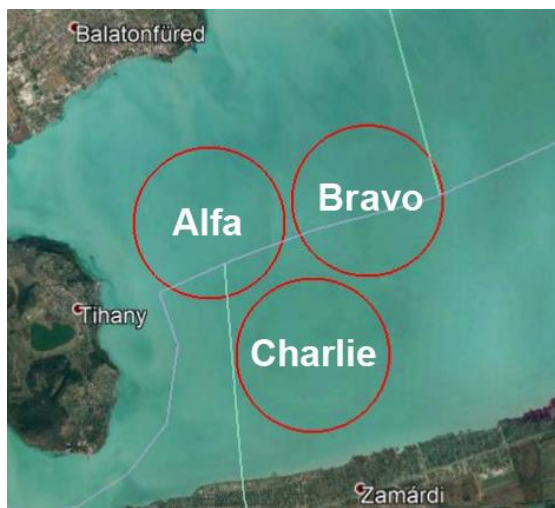
Type of vessel	Identification

Protest Committee	JURY on a white background
Media	MEDIA on a green background

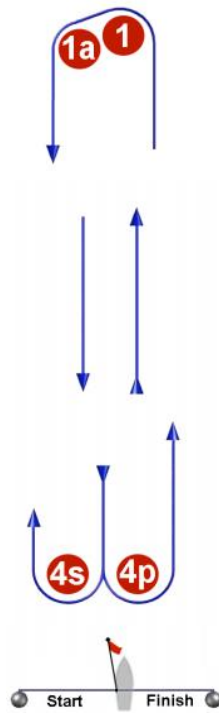
