NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS). Other documents under RRS Definition: Rule (g) include:
 - (a) RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, and
 - (b) RRS Appendix T, Arbitration.
- 1.2 The national authority prescriptions that apply are stated in full at [this link](#).
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4 Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Copies of the sailing instructions will be available at the race office during registration. The electronic version of the sailing instructions will be available no later than the start of the registration at <https://byc.hu/regatta/d-one-silver-cup2022/>.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at the entrance of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.
- 3.2 Notices will also be posted at <https://byc.hu/regatta/d-one-silver-cup2022/>. Failure to post or delay in posting a notice on the website will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1.
- 3.3 **[DP]** While racing, except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the D-One Class.
- 4.2 Each athlete shall be member of the International Class Association or their National Class Association.
- 4.3 Boats may enter the event by filling in the entry form at <https://byc.hu/regatta/d-one-silver-cup2022/>.
- 4.4 Registration: at the race office located in the clubroom of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.), between 18:00-20:00 on 7 September 2022 and between 7:30-8:00 on 8 September 2022.

4.5 Each athlete under 18 years old on 8 September 2022 shall bring to registration a completed parent/guardian consent form. The form is available at <https://byc.hu/regatta/d-one-silver-cup2022/>.

4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees no later than at registration.

5. FEES

5.1 The entry fee will be 270 EUR for each boat.

5.2 The early bird entry fee will be 200 EUR for each boat. Only boats entering and completing payment by 23:59 on 31 August 2022 will be eligible for the early bird entry fee.

5.3 Early bird entry fees shall be paid in EUR by bank transfer to the following account:

5.4 Entry fees may be paid during registration by cash or credit/debit cards.

6. [DP] ADVERTISING

6.1 Boats maybe required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1 Racing days, scheduled time of warning signals and number of races:

7.2 On the last scheduled day of racing (11 September 2022) no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

8. EQUIPMENT

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate at registration.

8.2 Each athlete shall be weighed during registration to determine wing settings.

8.3 All boats are required to comply with RRS 78.1 from 9:00 on 8 September 2022 onwards. Non-compliance from 9:00 on 8 September 2022 until the start of the first race shall be reported, protested and penalized as if it were discovered after racing on the first day on which races for that boat have been completed.

8.4 Penalties for breaches of class rules may, at the discretion of the protest committee be less than disqualification.



9. VENUE

- 9.1 A regatta center will be in the harbour of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club. The address of the harbour: 8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.
- 9.2 The racing areas will be the waters among Balatonfüred, Alsóörs, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1 Windward-leeward courses will be sailed with a target time of 50 minutes.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13. SUPPORT BOATS AND SUPPORT PERSONS

- 13.1 For the purposes of these instructions a support boat is any boat with support persons aboard.
- 13.2 Lake Balaton is a natural preservation area and the use of powerboats is strictly regulated by Hungarian law. Only boats with proper permits may be used as support boats for the event. Failure to obtain these permits may result in prosecution by the local authorities. There will be a limited number of temporary permits available for support boats. In order to obtain one, support boats shall initially register by 23:59 on 31 August 2022. To register, please contact the organizing authority for information regarding data to be submitted, fees and the content of the permit.
- 13.3 Support boats shall be registered by their drivers during registration. The registered driver(s) of a support boat will be responsible for the control of the boat at all times and will be held responsible for any inappropriate behavior or dangerous actions, or actions affecting the fairness or safety of competition.
- 13.4 Each support boat shall submit the sail numbers of the supported boats at registration. A support boat may support no more than ten boats entered.
- 13.5 Each support boat shall clearly display an identification number supplied at registration. A deposit of 3000 Ft or 10 EUR will be required for the identification number.
- 13.6 Each support boat is strongly recommended to carry a VHF radio on board.
- 13.7 Support boat drivers and all crew members on board shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while they are afloat with the engine of their support boat running.
- 13.8 It is strongly recommended that the kill cord is used at all times when the engine is running.
- 13.9 The use of drones by support boats is prohibited.
- 13.10 The movements of support boats will be restricted as defined in the sailing instructions.



14. [DP] BERTHING

14.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

15. PRIZES

15.1 The following prizes will be awarded:

- (a) Top 6 boats overall,
- (b) First Female Boat.
- (c) First Youth Boat (athlete born after 11 September 2004).

16. RISK STATEMENT

16.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes

17. INSURANCE

17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.

18. MEDIA RIGHTS

18.1 By entering the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
