



2022 OPEN J/24 HUNGARIAN CHAMPIONSHIP AND SUDÁR REGATTA HUNGARIAN CHAMPIONSHIP

BALATONFÜRED, 24-27 AUGUST 2022

Organizing Authority: Balatonfüredi Yacht Club, in conjunction with the Hungarian Sailing Federation

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS). Other documents under RRS Definition: Rule (g) include:
 - (a) *The Equipment Rules of Sailing*,
 - (b) the Regatta Regulations of the Hungarian Sailing Federation (RR),
 - (c) the Advertising Code of the Hungarian Sailing Federation,
 - (d) for the J/24 class, RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42.
- 1.2 Changes to rules only for the J/24 class:
 - (a) Class rule C.2.1(b) is changed to class rule J.4.3 that allows limited crew substitutions.
 - (b) Class rule C.10.2 will apply with the changes in class rule J.2 that allows using a spare spinnaker with limitations.
- 1.3 RRS 90.3(e) shall apply.
- 1.4 The national authority prescriptions that apply are stated in full at [this link](#).
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.
- 1.6 Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Copies of the sailing instructions will be available at the race office during registration. The electronic version of the sailing instructions will be available no later than the start of the registration at <https://byc.hu/regatta/j24-sr-ob2022/>.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at the entrance of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club.
- 3.2 Notices will also be posted at <https://byc.hu/regatta/j24-sr-ob2022/>. Failure to post or delay in posting a notice on the website will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1.
- 3.3 **[DP]** While racing, except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

- 3.4 When afloat, the race committee will transmit information to boats on marine VHF radios. Boats may transmit on the VHF channel specified by the race committee only when in an emergency or when retiring from a race. A boat may not request redress because of any failure in the transmission or the order in which OCS boats are announced. This changes RRS 60.1(b).

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the J/24 and Sudár Regatta classes.
- 4.2 Each competitor and boat shall comply with the requirements in RR 3.
- 4.3 Furthermore, in the J/24 class:
- (a) The event is open to J/24 class boats as defined by the IJCA class rules
 - (b) Championship helmspersons shall be either nationals or residents and members of the National J/24 Class Association of the country that they represent.
 - (c) If there are co-skippers, one of them shall be designated as the primary skipper for this event.
- 4.4 Entry
- (a) Online entry
 - (1) For competitors holding a license of the Hungarian Sailing Federation: in the VI-HAR system.
 - (2) For competitors from abroad, not holding a license of the Hungarian Sailing Federation in e-mail, at byc@byc.hu.
 - (b) On-site entry and registration
At the race office located in the clubroom of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club (8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.), between 17:00-20:00 on 23 August 2022.
- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees no later than at registration.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fee is 18.000 HUF per person, and 9.000 HUF for those born on or after 1 January 2004.
- 5.2 Entry fees shall be paid via bank transfer (only available in HUF currency) before registration or by cash or credit/debit cards during registration. Details of the bank transfer are the following:

- 5.3 Entry fees may be paid in EUR currency at the time and place of the registration, based on the daily exchange rate.

6. [DP] ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.



7. SCHEDULE

7.1 On each racing day, the race committee will hold a competitors' briefing 90 minutes before the first scheduled warning signal of the day in the regatta centre.

7.2 Racing days, scheduled time of warning signals and number of races:

7.3 On the last scheduled day of racing (27 August 2022) no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

8. EQUIPMENT

8.1 Each boat of the J/24 class shall present by the end of the on-site entry and registration the following:

(a) A valid, IJCA issued Measurement Certificate, Including Part C: Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment. Boats that do not have a valid, IJCA issued Measurement Certificate must make arrangements to have their boat measured prior to the regatta. No first time or full measurement will be available during registration.

(b) Proof of J/24 Class Association membership in the country they represent for the owner and the helmsperson.

8.2 Each boat of the Sudár Regatta class shall present a valid measurement certificate before the end of the on-site entry and registration.

8.3 Each crew member in the J/24 class shall be weighed during the on-site entry and registration to confirm that the total weight of the crew is within the limit stated in the class rules. Competitors shall be ready to produce photo identification at weigh-in.

8.4 All boats are required to comply with RRS 78.1 from 9:00 on 24 August 2022 onwards. Non-compliance from 9:00 on 24 August 2022 until the start of the first race shall be reported, protested and penalized as if it were discovered after racing on the first day on which races for that boat have been completed.

8.5 Penalties for breaches of class rules may, at the discretion of the protest committee be less than disqualification.

9. VENUE

9.1 A regatta centre will be in the harbour of the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club. The address of the harbour: 8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 2.

9.2 The racing areas will be the waters among Balatonfüred, Alsóörs, Siófok, Zamárdi and Tihany.

10. THE COURSES

10.1 Windward-leeward courses will be sailed.



11. SCORING

- 11.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series in the Hungarian Championships.
- 11.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When four or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. [DP] BERTHING

- 12.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

13. [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 13.1 All boats shall be afloat by 9:00 on 24 August 2022. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. This includes rudders for the J/24 class.

14. [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT, PLASTIC POOLS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS

- 14.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 14.2 Careening by any means for the purpose of cleaning or inspecting the hull is prohibited during the regatta.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1 The top three boats of the J/24 Open Hungarian Championship will be awarded.
- 15.2 The top six boats of the J/24 Hungarian Championship and the top 3 boats of the Sudár Regatta Hungarian Championship will be awarded.
- 15.3 The winner of the first race in each class will be awarded the Tóth László Memorial Trophy.
- 15.4 The first boat in the third completed race in the J/24 class will be awarded the Litkey Bence Memorial Trophy.
- 15.5 The first boat in the last completed race in the Sudár Regatta class will be awarded the Belo Memorial Race Perpetual Trophy.

16. RISK STATEMENT

- 16.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes

17. INSURANCE

- 17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 50 Million HUF per incident or the equivalent.



18. MEDIA RIGHTS

18.1 Competitors grant to the Balatonfüredi Yacht Club and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
